Worship Leader: It is God who holds both heaven and earth in a single peace. It is His design for His great love to shine upon our lives. It is His hope that we would have peace in His Church, peace among nations, peace in our communities, peace in our homes and peace in our hearts.

Leader #1: Do you have a vision of God's Peace?

All: It is to live in harmony with one another, be sympathetic, love as brothers and sisters, be compassionate and humble. Do not repay evil with evil or insult, but with blessing, because to this you were called.

Leader #2: Do you have a vision of Christian peacemaking?

All: Put your sword back in its place, said Jesus, for all who draw the sword will die by the sword.

Leader #3: Do you have a vision of Christian community?

All: There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

Leader #1: Do you have a vision of the Christian in the world?

All: The Lord God says to His servant, I the Lord have called you and given you power to see that justice is done on earth.

Leader #2: Do you have a vision of Jesus' way with conflict?

Leader #3: Do you have a vision of Christian leadership?

Leader #1: Do you have a vision of Christian discipleship?

Leader #2: Have you glimpsed God's vision?
